The Grants-in-aid is released subject to the following conditions:

 That the sanctioned funds are exclusively meant for payment of Incentive @ 5% on consolidated remuneration the monthly w.e.f. April 2020 to December 2020 in favour of contractual manpower engaged under NHM (including NUHM) strictly as per terms & conditions mentioned in the enclosed Order No.95 of 2020 dated 11/11/, after adhering to various guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI and observing all codal formalities required under rules.

That no diversion of funds shall be made without approval of competent authority.

- That the funds shall be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and also ensure that there may not be duplication of similar activities from other source.
- 4. That the District Health Societies shall accept the funds on PFMS portal after confirming the same from their bank accounts and subsequently release funds to the Block/downward health institutions within three (3) days through the same portal/e-transfer under intimation to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K. Further, Districts/Blocks shall also ensure that all the expenditure have to be uploaded on PFMS portal and implement the EAT module of PFMS.

5. That the District Health Societies shall ensure to utilize the funds through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode on PFMS Portal and submit the DBT payments details to the State Health Society by or before 5th of next month mandatorily for further

updating to higher authority.

 That the timely submission of Concurrent Audit Report & compliance to the observations made in the Statutory Audit Report.

7. That the Physical/Financial achievements (MPR/FMR) are to be sent to the State

Health Society on regular basis.

That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Books, Ledgers, Assets created, complete
address of beneficiaries and other relevant records are to be maintained at all levels

strictly as per the financial guidelines by MoH&FW, GoI.

9. That the accounts of the District Health Societies shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI.
