That the health institution shall accept the funds on PFMS portal after confirming the same from its bank account and subsequently release funds to the concerned immediately through the said portal/e-transfer under intimation to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K and also ensure expenditure be uploaded on PFMS Portal.
- 3. That no diversion /re-appropriation of funds shall be made without approval of competent authority.
- 4. That the funds are to be utilized after observing all codal formalities required under rules and as per guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI.
- 5. That the Statement of Expenditure along with line listing of beneficiaries and Utilization Certificates are to be sent to the State Health Society.
- 6. That the detailed beneficiaries' data of SNCU like admission of children, treatment and follow up etc. is to be uploaded on www.sncuonlineindia.org regularly.
- 7. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Book, Ledger, Assets Register and other relevant records are to be maintained for inspection of any visiting team from Central/State Government.

That the accounts of the grantee/organization shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI, whenever the grantee/Society is called upon to do so.
