 NHM, J&K and also ensure expenditure be uploaded on PFMS Portal.

 That no diversion /re-appropriation of funds shall be made without approval of State Health Society.

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 That as per the directions of GoI & Aadhaar Act, 2016, Aadhaar Number being mandatory to receive any social benefits. The health institution shall ensure 100% Aadhaar seeding of all Contractual Staff engaged under NHM.

6. That the Physical/Financial achievements are to be sent to the State Health

Society on regular basis in terms of number testing done.

7. That the monthly Statement of Expenditure and Utilization certificate are to be sent to the State Health Society regularly.

 That the funds shall be utilized to fill up the gaps to deal with COVID-19 pandemic and also ensure that there may not be duplication of similar activities from other source.

That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Book, Ledger, Assets Register and other relevant records are to be maintained for inspection of any visiting team from Central/State Government.

That the accounts of grantee/organization shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provisions of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI, whenever the grantee/Society is called upon to do so.
