The Grant-in-aid is released subject to the following conditions:

- That the sanctioned funds are to be utilized for ASHAs' Assured Incentive for routine and recurring activities & Additional Incentives for COVID-19 related work, from the period of their engagement in this work between 01/01/2020 and 30/06/2020 under NHM, strictly as per the rates and terms & conditions of guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI vide above referred communications and after observing all codal formalities required under rules.
- 2. That District shall not make any changes in allocations or re-appropriations amongst different components / activities without approval from State Health Society.
- That the District Health Societies shall accept the funds on PFMS portal after confirming the same from their bank accounts and subsequently release funds to the Blocks/downward health institutions within two (2) days through the same portal/ e- transfer under intimation to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K. Further, Districts/Blocks shall also ensure that all the expenditure to be uploaded on PFMS portal and implement the EAT module of PFMS.
- That the District Health Societies ensure that all the payments of Incentives to ASHAs are to 4. be made only through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode on PFMS portal and submit the DBT payments details to the State Health Society by or before 5th of next month mandatorily for further updating DBT Bharat portal.
- That the timely submission of Concurrent Audit Report & compliance to the observations 5. made in the Statutory Audit Report.
- That the monthly FMR is to be submitted in customized Tally ERP to the State Health 6. Society on regular basis.
- That the Physical/Financial achievements are to be sent to the State Health Society on regular 7.
- 8. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Books, Ledgers, Assets created, complete address of beneficiaries and other relevant records are to be maintained at all levels strictly as per the financial guidelines by MoH&FW, Gol.
- That the accounts of the District Health Societies/grantee institutions/organizations shall be 9. open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI and whenever the society is called upon to do so.
