Madam/Sir,

As per the approval conveyed by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI under India COVID-19 Emergency Response and Health System Strengthening Preparedness Package, sanction is hereby accorded for release of additional Grants-in-Aid of *Rs.87,030/- (Rupees Eighty Seven Thousand and Thirty only)* on account of 2 (two) left out DEOs @ Rs.14505/- pm for a period w.e.f. 1/01/2021 to 31/03/2021 for data entry operations on the portals of COVID-19 at below mentioned health institution under NHM, J&K. However, the term of extension of 4 (four) DEOs for first three (3) months of 2021-22 shall be communicated separately:

Accordingly, above sanctioned funds are electronically transferred through PFMS portal/e-transfer into your Bank Account, with the request to transfer these funds in favour of concerned Drawing & Disbursing Officers (DDOs), for the said purpose under intimation to this office.

The Grants-in-Aid sanctioned is subject to following terms & conditions:

That the funds shall be utilized towards manpower engaged for data entry operations
on portals maintaining for COVID-19 related data at COVID Hospital, after
observing all codal formalities required under rules and according to the guidelines
issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India for COVID-19.

2. That the State Health Society will release funds on PFMS portal and the same shall be accepted after confirming receipt of funds from your bank. Subsequent transfer/utilization of these funds shall be preferably through PFMS portal.

That these funds shall be immediately transferred to concerned Drawing & Disbursing Officers (DDOs) to timely clear the Invoices of out-sourcing Agency of such manpower. Concerned DDOs, along with Controlling Officers, shall also ensure timely and regular data entry operations on portals of COVID-19.

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That in view of process initiated by State Health Society, NHM, J&K for relocation/ 4. rationalization of manpower already engaged for data entry operations in various healthcare facilities.

No manpower for data entry operations or any other Programme/Scheme under 5.

NHM, shall be hired by Implementing Agencies at its own;

Any vacancy arising due to resignation of manpower presently engaged for data 6. entry operations under any Programme/Scheme of NHM, be filled up only in consultation with the State Health Society, NHM, J&K; and

In exceptional cases, wherever required, Implementing Agencies shall submit its 7. requirements with respect to any manpower for data entry operations relating to the Programmes/Schemes of NHM, along with substantiating justifications including, manpower already engaged for data entry operations, workload, etc. to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K for appropriate necessary action.

That the Optimum utilization of funds shall be ensured along with avoidance of 8. unnecessary parking of funds. Further funds will be released after receipt of Statement of Expenditure/Utilization Certificate by the State Health Society before

5th of next month.

That the proper record of Cash Book, Ledger, Asset Register and other records be 9. maintained under seal & signatures of the concerned officers and shall be made

available for checking by any of the visiting team from Central/ State Govt.

That the accounts of Implementing Agencies/ District Health Societies shall be open 10. to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit both by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provisions of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, whenever called upon to do so.
