 That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Book, Ledger, Assets and other relevant records are to be maintained for inspection of any visiting team Central/State Govt.

6. That the accounts of the grantee shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, whenever the society is called upon to do so.
