Accordingly, sanctioned GIA of Rs.227.97 Lac (Rupees Two Crore Twenty Seven Lac and Ninety Seven Thousand only) is hereby electronically transferred into the official bank accounts of your District Health Society through e-transfer.

The Grants-in-aid is released subject to the following conditions:

- That the sanctioned funds and authorization for utilization of unspent balance as on 31/12/2021 under ECRP-I are to be utilized only for the disbursement of Additional Incentives to ASHA Workers for COVID related tasks for the period of three months, strictly as per the rates and terms & conditions of guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI vide above referred communications and after observing all codal formalities required under rules of ECRP-I/GFR 2017.
- That the Districts shall not make any changes in allocations or re-appropriations amongst different components / activities without approval from State Health Society.
- That the District Health Societies shall immediately release these funds alongwith authorization to the blocks/downward health institutions through e-transfer under intimation to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K. Further, Districts/Blocks will ensure that the expenditure under this activity be reported this office.

4. That the District Health Societies shall ensure that Incentives to ASHAs for COVID related tasks are to be made only directly into the bank account of ASHA Workers through e-transfer

(strictly no cash/cheque payments).

That the timely submission of Quarterly Concurrent Audit Report & compliance to the observations of Statutory Auditors is mandatory.

6. That the monthly FMR is to be submitted to the State Health Society on regular basis.

 That the Physical/Financial achievements are to be sent to the State Health Society on regular basis.

That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Books, Ledgers, Assets created, complete
address of beneficiaries and other relevant records are to be maintained at all levels strictly as

per the financial guidelines by MoH&FW, GoI.

9. That the accounts of the District Health Societies/grantee institutions/organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI and whenever the society is called upon to do so.
