Madam,

In referrence to the above communications, sanction is hereby accorded to the release of Grant-in-Aid of *Rs. 46.00 Lac (Rupees Forty Six Lakh only)* under India COVID-19 Emergency Response and Health System Strengthening Preparedness Package (ECRP-II) for the financial year 2021-22. (FMR Code: S.3 "Enhancement of Human Resource for Health) to clear the pending payments of M/s Tiranga Security and Manpower Solutions for supply of manpower i.e DEO/Nursing Orderlies/Sanitary workers to DRDO Covid Care Hospital Jammu on outsourced basis


Accordingly, the sanctioned funds are hereby transferred through e-transfer into the official Bank A/c No. **0373040500000035** of Principal, Govt. Medical College, Jammu maintained with J&K Bank Ltd; Govt. Medical College, Jammu with the request to disburse the payments of outsourced staff immediately by transferring to outsourcing agency as per the terms and conditions of their rate contract.

The Grants-in-Aid is sanctioned subject to the following conditions:

1. That the above sanctioned funds are to be utilized only for payment of manpower engaged on outsourcing basis for DRDO Covid Care Hospital Jammu strictly as per the rates, terms and conditions of contract/their engagement after observing all codal formalities required under rules and guidelines of MoH&FW, GoI.
2. That no diversion/reappropriation of funds is permissible without approval of the Competent Authority.
3. That as per the directions of GoI & Aadhaar Act 2016, Aadhaar Number being mandatory to receive any social benefits. The health institutions shall ensure 100% seeding of all contractual staff engaged for Covid care hospitals.
4. The payment of the manpower shall be disbursed on the basis of their attendance/performance.
5. That the funds shall be utilized to fill up the gaps to deal with COVID-19 pandemic and also ensure that there may not be duplication of similar activities from the other source.
6. That the statement of expenditure alongwith Utilization Certificate in GFR format form 12(C) be provided to this office monthly basis.

7. That the accounts of the grantee shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, whenever the society is called upon to do so.
