
Accordingly the above sanctioned GIA is transferred to your Bank Account No.SG-5198 of J & K Bank Ltd, old Secretariat, Srinagar under the head Base Flexipool.

The Grant-in-Aid is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the above GIA sanctioned is exclusively meant for Installation of VTMS in ambulances as per approved rate contract for VTMS, Establishment of one Control Room for 102 Services and Colour Coding of the Ambulances under "National Ambulance Services (NAS)" in Kashmir division strictly as per approved rate contract.
2. That Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir will work out a time bound schedule for fitting of GPS devices in all on road ambulances (except for Eicher ambulances which are under process of replacement) within one month without effecting existing services.
3. That the process of establishment of Control Rooms shall be completed within 10 days.
4. That the funds sanctioned are utilized strictly as per the guidelines issued by the MOH&FW, GOI and after observing all codal formalities required under rules.
5. That the proper record of Cash Book, Ledger, Assets and other relevant record is maintained at all levels for check of any visiting team Central/State Govt. team.
6. That the monthly Statement of Expenditure & Utilization Certificate is sent to the State Health Society regularly.

7. The account of the grantee shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal Audit by Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, whenever the society is called upon to do so.
