

2. That the proper record of Cash, book ledgers complete address alongwith mobile number of beneficiaries and other relevant records are to be maintained for check of any visiting team from Central/State Government.
3. That the account of the guarantee shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal Audit by Principal Accounts Office of the ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, whenever the society is called upon to do so.
4. That the list of JSSK/JSY beneficiaries will be provided to the State Health Society on monthly basis, which should be uploaded on the website www.jknhm.com under "**Mandatory Disclosures**".
5. That the Physical activities like Institutional Deliveries, should be uploaded in HMIS web portal <http://nrhm-mis.nic.in> which is the only source of authenticate data.

6. That the Institutions shall ensure the display of JSSK and JSY slogans on hoardings at prominent places of their respective institution/every Obstetric ward.
