- 2. That funds to be utilized after observing all codal formalities required under rules and as per the guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI in this regard under NHM.
- 3. That the statement of Expenditure and Utilization certificate are to be sent to the State Health Society regularly.
- 4. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Books, Ledgers, Assets Register and other relevant records are to be maintained for check of any visiting team from Central/State Government.
- 5. That the timely compliance to the observations made in the Statutory Audit Report.
