Sub: Release of GIA under RCH Flexible pool for implementation of JSSK Scheme during the year 2016-17.

Sir,

Sanction is hereby accorded to release of Grant-in-Aid of **Rs.100.00 Lac (Rupees One Core only)** i.e. **Rs.50.00 Lac** for Govt. LD Hospital Srinagar and **Rs.50.00 Lacs** for Govt. G.B. Pant/Children Hospital, Srinagar for implementation of Janani Shishu Surakhsha Karyakaram (JSSK) Scheme in pursuance to Govt. order No.491-HME of 2013 dated 30-8-2013, issued regarding exemption of user charges and free entitlements to all pregnant women delivering in Public Health Institution and sick neonates up to 0-1 year with zero out of pockets expenses under JSSK Scheme.

Accordingly, **Rs.100.00 Lac (Rupees One Core only)** is hereby electronically transferred to your official Bank A/c No.SBG-9 of J&K Bank Ltd, Govt. Medical College Srinagar.


You are, therefore, requested to release these funds immediately to the **Medical Superintendent, Govt. LD Hospital & G.B. Pant/Children Srinagar** for implementation of the JSSK Scheme during the current financial year 2016-17.

The Grant-in-Aid is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the released funds are to be utilized to implement the JSSK Scheme at above mentioned hospitals, strictly as per the guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI and after observing all codal formalities required under rules/financial guidelines, which are also available on website of NHM.
2. ***That the funds released will not be utilized to clear any kind of liabilities of the previous years.***
3. That the establishment of centralized Call Centre along with toll free number is a mandatory requirement for providing referral transport services to the pregnant women and neonates.
4. That the all purchases are to be made after observing all codal formalities required under rules.
5. That the cash reimbursement to the beneficiaries for referral transport is not permissible.
6. That the full justification of referral and type of complication is recorded at tertiary centre. Referral in and Referral out Registers are to be maintained in the health facility.
7. That the proper record of drugs and consumables issued to beneficiaries are to be maintained. The list of essential drugs specified by MoH&FW, GoI and its availability is to be ensured at health facility. No Cash reimbursement is allowed.
8. That the JSSK funds are to be utilized strictly as per the Govt. Order No. 491-HME of 2013 dated 30-8-2013.
9. That the healthy diet to the pregnant women is to be provided as per the permissibility under the close supervision of HODs of the concerned department and proper record is to be maintained. No Cash reimbursement is allowed.

10. *That the health facility shall follow the financial management system under NHM and shall submit the Physical/Financial achievements (Expenditure/Utilization Certificate) head wise i.e. Drugs & Consumables, Diagnostics, Blood Transfusion, Diet, Referral Transport and drop back for pregnant women on monthly basis.*
11. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Book, Ledger, Assets created, complete address of beneficiaries and other relevant records are to be maintained for check of any visiting team from Central/State Government.
12. That the timely compliance to the observations raised in the Statutory Audit Report is to be done.
13. That the accounts of the guarantee shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal Audit by Principal Accounts Office of the ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, whenever the society is called upon to do so.
14. The list of JSSK beneficiaries will be provided to the State Health Society on monthly basis, which should be uploaded on the website www.jknrhnm.com under "Mandatory Disclosures".
15. That the Physical activities like Institutional Deliveries, should be uploaded in HMIS web portal <http://nrhm-mis.nic.in> which is the only source of authenticate data.
16. That the Institutions shall ensure the display of JSSK slogans on hoardings at prominent places of their respective institution/every Obstetric ward.
17. The detailed guidelines of JSSK prepared by the State Health Society are available on the website www.jkhealth.org, www.jknrhnm.com
18. *That all the instructions issued regarding the implementation of JSSK Scheme vide Advisory No. SHS/NHM/J&K/FMG/4967-95 dated 11/7/2016 shall have to be adhered to in letter and spirit.*
