- 1. Grant-in-Aid is sanctioned as per NIC's initial budget estimates submitted to the MoH&FW, Govt. of India for approval and the approval accorded by the MoH&FW, Govt. of India for the project for the year - 2016-17 including clearance of pending liabilities on account of HR for the year - 2015-16.
- 2. NIC being the Implementing Agency and having technical expertise shall be responsible for execution of project. Matters regarding hiring of manpower and their extension shall be addressed by the NIC/ NICSI as per their requirements for the project.
- 3. Grant-in-Aid is sanctioned exclusively for HR hired under ICT Project (e-Hospital Solution) in 2 District Hospitals, 4 CHCs and 10 PHCs under NHM.
- 4. Status of manpower hired under e-Hospital shall be certified by the Controlling Officers of respective Institutions and remuneration shall be released only after issuance of attendance and certification of work-done reports by the concerned Medical Superintendents/ Block Medical Officers.



- 5. Funds shall be utilized strictly in accordance with the activities approved by the MoH&FW, Govt. of India after observing all codal formalities required under Rules.
- 6. Proper record of Cash Book, Ledger, Asset Register and other records shall be maintained under seal & signatures of the concerned Controlling Officers and shall be made available for checking by any of the visiting team from Central/ State Govt.
- 7. Monthly Statement of Expenditure/ Utilization Certificate is to be sent to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K on regular basis by 05th of next month. Further release of funds will be subject to regular receipt of Physical and Financial performance reports from the respective Health Institutions duly certified by the Officer In-charge of NIC and the concerned Medical Superintendents/ Block Medical Officers.
- 8. The account of the Implementing Agency shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal Audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of the Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India whenever the Implementing Agency is called upon to do so.
- 9. All others terms & conditions as mentioned in the NIC initial proposal shall form part of this release order.
