Subject: Tour report of Dr Aadil Bashir Assistant Programme Manager (ASHA), NHM, J&K

In compliance to your order no.32of 2015 dated 06-06-2015, i had visited District Doda accompanied with Mr Vikas Sheemar National Monitor by MoH&FW GoI, for monitoring of Mission Indradhanush Round 3rd in district Doda, visited different session sites & cold chain points w.e.f. 8th June 2015 to 11th June, 2015. Following are the observations of the tour:-

Date:-08-06-2015

District Doda Block Ghat:

On the day of Visitwe had interaction with CMO and Deputy CMO regarding Mission Indradhanush, they have informed us that first two sessions have been completed according to micro-plan and third sessions is going on.

Observation of Mission Indradhanush at Block Ghat.:

- ➤ Visited session site with BMO Ghat.
- > The sessions were conducted as per plan and strategic locations.
- As per the guideline IEC is a crucial component of Mission Indradhanush and districts have to ensure the IEC activities are implemented before and during the session dates.
- ➤ During the visit No Hoardings /Posters /Banners /Pamphlets /Leaflets were seen at any session site /Health centers /public places.
- ➤ No IEC activity was under taken by the block.
- ➤ In round 1st 417 children are being immunized and 152 sessions covered reported by BMO
- ➤ In round 2nd 235 children's are being immunized and 102 sessions covered.
- Round 3rd was started on the day of visit.
- > ASHAs of block Ghat were not actively involved in the Mission Indradhnush.
- ➤ Headcount/ due list was prepared by block and they were aware about Mission Indradhanush and its activities pertaining to them.
- ➤ Needle Cutter was not available at the session site.
- There was non-availability of Red & Black bag for dumping of immunization waste. Used syringes & needles were thrown openly.

- ➤ The sessions were conducted as per the micro-plan and at locations where dropout rate was more in order to covermaximum number of beneficiaries
- ➤ No Hoardings/ Posters/ Banners/ Pamphlets/ Leaflets were seen at any Session site and at PHC

- > ANMs/ ASHAs were not trained properly on implementation of Mission Indradhanush
- ➤ Head count due lists were prepared by ANMs
- ➤ Vaccines were available at the facility.
- > Two rounds of Mission Indradanush are completed with following details:
 - (a) 1st round total sessions held are 60
 - (b) 1st round total childrens covered are 44
 - (c) 2nd round total sessions held are 13
 - (d) 2nd round total childrens covered are 25
- ➤ The vaccines were brought by ANM the previous night for session site and kept them in the household fridge

Observations of Mission Indradhanush at Block Baderwah

- The sessions were conducted as per plan and strategic locations
- ➤ Though the areas are hard to reach but several sessions were conducted to cover maximum numbers and beneficiaries
- ➤ Headcount/ due list was prepared by ANMs/ASHAs
- > Following major points were observed during the session site
 - (a) Needle cutter was not available at the session site.
 - (b) MCP cards were not available with the ANM.
 - (c) The vaccines were brought by ANM from SDH to session site.
 - (d)There was non-availability of Red & Black bag for dumping of immunization waste. Used syringes & needles were thrown openly
 - (e) None of the opened vaccine vial had date & time of opening marked on it.
- ➤ All the vaccines were available.
- > Two rounds of Mission Indradhanush was completed with following details:-
 - 1. 1st round total sessions held are 47
 - 2. 1st round total childrens covered are 211.
 - 3. 2nd round total sessions held are 37.
 - 4. 2nd round total childrens covered are 206.
- > Total number of supervisors identified for Mission Indradhanush is 10.

- ➤ Concern BMO was on leave and their was no other medical officer because there is only one Medical officer who is BMO also, so we took the information regarding Mission Indradhanush from BMEO.
- ➤ There was no activity /session of Mission Indradhanush planned on the day of visit.

- ➤ All the vaccines were available and cold chain was maintained.
- ➤ The micro-plans prepared were incomplete as there were no details of beneficiaries to be covered.
- ➤ IEC of Mission Indradhanush was not printed nor were Hoardings /Posters displayed in the PHC.
- ➤ While interaction with ASHAs at PHC they were not fully aware about Mission Indradhanush.
- > Two rounds of Mission Indradhanush was completed with following details:
 - 1.1st round total sessions held are 29
 - 2.1st round total childrens covered are 105.
 - 3. 2nd round total sessions held are 14.
 - 4. 2nd round total childrens covered are 128.
