- Funds shall be utilized in accordance with budget sheets conveyed vide this office communication No.: SHS/J&K/NHM/FMG/12238-56 dated: 01.11.2017 after observing all codal formalities required under rules and according to the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. Govt. of India which are available on the website http://nrhm.gov.in/.
- Allocation of funds for respective Programmes covered under flexible pool for Non-Communicable Diseases be made only after analysing the status of funds available under these Programmes and prioritization of activities/ need under regular intimation to this office.
- 3. Preference should be given for release of pending remuneration of human resource engaged under these Programmes, ASHA incentives and other core activities.
- 4. State Health Society will release the funds in your favour on PFMS portal and the same shall be accepted after confirming receipt of funds from your bank and subsequently release these funds in favour of concerned units at Divisional/ selected District level through PFMS portal.
- 5. Procurement of Drugs & Consumables shall be made through J&K Medical Supplies Corporation Ltd. and in case of exigencies, as per the instructions conveyed by the Administrative Department from time to time.

- 6. In view of receipt of funds from the MoH&FW, Govt. of India in progressive manner and only after submission of the utilization certificate, prioritization of activities approved under these Programmes shall be made so that ongoing activities may not suffer.
