Sub: Release of funds for implementation of Population Based Screening of Non-Communicable Diseases during 2018-19 - reg.

Sir.

In light of the decision of the Executive Committee meeting held on 28th August, 20.8 and the instructions from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India emphasizing upon implementation of population based screening for Non-Communicable Diseases during – 2018-19, sanction is hereby accorded for release of Rs.192.00 Lakhs (Rupees One Crore and Ninety Two Lakhs only) as Grant-in-Aid for procurement of equipment & consumables and trainings required for implementation of population based screening of Non-Communicable Diseases in the identified Districts, viz., Doda, Jammu & Udhampur in Jammu Division and Anantnag, Baramulla & Kupwara in Kashmir Division, during the financial year - 2018-19.

The GIA sanctioned is subject to following terms and conditions:

The above GIA is for procurement of Equipment for Hypertension, Diabetes & Oral-Visual Examination and Consumables including Gluco-strips, Lancets, Wooden Sticks, Gloves, Cotton, Gauze, etc. to ensure population based screening of NCDs in the identified Districts viz., Doda, Jammu & Udhampur in Jammu Division and Anantnag, Baramulla & Kupwara in Kashmir Division.

2. Funds shall be utilized for the approved activities after thoroughly analysing existing status of equipment/consumables at respective health institutions.

3. Procurement of Drugs & Consumables shall be made after observing all codal formalities required under rules and according to the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India which are available on the website http://nhm.gov.in/.

4. In view of receipt of funds from the MoH&FW, Govt. of India in progressive manner and only after submission of the utilization certificate, prioritization of various activities approved under NPCDCS shall be made so that other ongoing activities may not suffer.

5. Optimum utilization of funds shall be ensured alongwith avoidance of unnecessary - parking of funds.

- 6. State Health Society will release the funds in your favour on PFMS portal and the same shall be accepted after confirming receipt of funds from your bank and subsequently release/ utilization of these funds through PFMS portal.
- Proper record of Cash Book, Ledger, Asset Register and other records be maintained under seal & signatures of the concerned officers and shall be made available for checking by any of the visiting team from Central/ State Govt.

8. Separate assets register for the Programmes be maintained under seal & signatures of Head of the Institution.

9. Statement of Expenditure (SoE) and Utilization Certificate (UC) should be sent to State Health Society on monthly basis before 5th of next month.

10. Physical achievements/ work done of these Programmes, alongwith line listing, should

be regularly sent to State Health Society on monthly basis.

11. Further funds, if required for the purpose, will be released only after submission of physical and financial progress, alongwith end utilization/ consumption certificates, with respect to implementation of population based screening in respective Districts.

12. The account of the Implementing Agencies/ District Health Society shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of the Health & Family Welfare, Gol whenever the Society is called upon to do so.
