The Grant-in-Aid is subject to the following conditions:

 That the above sanctioned funds are exclusively meant for award of District Hospitals under "KAYAKALP" award scheme and to be utilized strictly as per guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI in this regard and after observing all codal formalities required under rules.

- That the District Health Societies shall accept the funds on the portal of PFMS after confirming same from their bank accounts and subsequently release funds to District Hospitals similarly on the said portal, and the Districts/Hospital ensure timely filing of expenditure on the PFMS portal.
- 3. That the FMR should be submitted in customized Tally ERP to the State Health Society on regular basis.
- 4. That the Physical/Financial achievements are to be sent to the State Health Society on regular basis.
- That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Book, Ledger, Assets and other relevant record are to be maintained for inspection of any visiting team Central/State Govt.
- 6. That the monthly statements of expenditure and utilisation certificate are to be sent to the State Health Society regularly.
- 7. That the accounts of the grantee shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal Audit by Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, whenever the society is called upon to do so.
