The Grant-in-Aid released is subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the sanctioned funds are to be utilized strictly for the activities approved under Mission Flexible Pool as per the rates and terms & conditions contained in the Districts' Budget Sheets and as per the guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI after observing all codal formalities required under rules.



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- 2. That the preference is to be given to remuneration of manpower hired under NHM, outsourced staff, incentives to ASHAs and doctors working in difficult areas, other core activities of Mission Flexible Pool and the Districts/ Blocks will ensure that no liabilities of previous years are to be cleared out of these funds.
- That all the DDOs are advised to mandatorily release the incentives to the doctors working under NHM in difficult areas alongwith their remunerations as instructed vide this office letter No.SHS/NHM/J&K/24318-75 dated 23/03/2017.
- That the procurement of drugs and consumables shall be made through J&K Medical Supplies Corporation Ltd. and in case of exigencies as per the instructions issued from time to time in this regard by the Administrative Department.
- That the District Health Societies shall accept the funds on PFMS portal after confirming the same from their bank accounts and subsequently release funds to the blocks immediately through the said portal/e-transfer under intimation to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K. Further, Districts/Blocks shall also ensure that all the expenditure have to be filed on/through PFMS portal.
- That the District Health Societies are to ensure that ASHA payments are to be made only through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode.
- That the timely submission of Concurrent Audit Report & compliance to the observations of Statutory Auditor is to be done.
- That the FMR should be submitted in customized Tally ERP to the State Health Society on regular
- That the Physical/Financial achievements are to be sent to the State Health Society on regular basis.
- 10. That the Physical activities like RKS meetings are to be uploaded in HMIS web portal http://nrhmmis.nic.in which is only the source of authenticated data.
- 11. That the monthly performance data (like ANCs, Deliveries, PNCs, Family Planning, Immunization etc), quarterly infrastructure details and other related services data is to be uploaded on HMIS web portal as per the mandate of MoH&FW, Gol.
- 12. That the District Health Societies/Health Institutions shall ensure the display of JSY/JSSK slogans and other benefits/entitlements under NHM on hoardings at prominent places of their respective
- 13. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Books, Ledgers. Assets created, complete address of beneficiaries and other relevant records are to be maintained at all levels strictly as per the financial guidelines by MoH&FW, Gol.
- 14. That the accounts of the District Health Societies/other institutions/organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and Internal Audit by Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Gol. Whenever the society is called upon to do so.
