## The Grant-in-Aid released is subject to following conditions:-

- 1. That the sanctioned GIA is exclusively meant for conducting the training of ASHAs in round-4 of HBNC Module VI & VII under Mission Flexible Pool.
- 2. That the funds are to be utilized strictly as per the enclosed estimated budget sheet for the said training and as per the guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI after observing all codal formalities required under rules (strictly no cash payments).
- 3. That the District Health Societies shall not make change in allocation.
- 4. That the District Health Societies shall accept the funds on PFMS portal after confirming the same from their bank accounts and subsequently release funds to the District Hospitals immediately through the same portal/e-transfer under intimation to the State Health Society, NHM, J&K. Further, District shall also ensure that all the expenditure have to be filed on/through PFMS portal.
- 5. That the timely submission of Concurrent Audit Report & compliance to the observations made in the Statutory Audit Report is to be done.
- 6. That the FMR should be submitted in customized Tally ERP to State Health Society on regular basis.
- 7. That the monthly Physical/Financial achievements are to be sent to State Health Society on regular basis.
- 8. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Books, Ledgers, Assets created, complete address of beneficiaries and other relevant records are to be maintained at all levels strictly as per the financial guidelines by MoH&FW, GoI.
- 9. That the accounts of the District Health Societies/other institutions/organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and Internal Audit by Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI. Whenever the society is called upon to do so.
