The GIA sanctioned is subject to following terms and conditions:-

- 1. Funds shall be utilized in accordance with budget sheets conveyed vide this office communication No.: SHS/J&K/NHM/FMG/22300-18 dated: 12.09.2018, after observing all codal formalities required under rules and according to the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India which are available on the website http://nrhm.gov.in/.
- 2. Preference should be given for release of pending remuneration of human resource engaged under this Programme, ASHA incentives and other core activities.
- 3. State Health Society will release the funds on PFMS Portal and the same shall be accepted after confirming receipt of funds from your bank and subsequent release of these funds in favour of concerned units/ Implementing Agencies at Divisional/ selected District level shall be through PFMS portal and ensure that expenditure be uploaded on same portal.
- 4. Procurement of Drugs & Consumables shall be made through J&K Medical Supplies Corporation Ltd. and in case of exigencies, as per the instructions conveyed by the Administrative department from time to time.

- 5. In view of receipt of funds from the MoH&FW, Govt. of India in progressive manner and only after submission of the utilization certificate, prioritization of activities approved under these Programmes shall be made so that ongoing activities may not suffer.
- 6. Optimum utilization of funds shall be ensured alongwith avoidance of unnecessary parking of funds.
- 7. Proper record of Cash Book, Ledger, Asset Register and other records be maintained under seal & signatures of the concerned officers and shall be made available for checking by any of the visiting team from Central/ State Govt.
- 8. Separate assets register for the Programmes be maintained under seal & signatures of Head of the institution.
- 9. Statement of Expenditure (SoE) and Utilization Certificate (UC) should be sent to State Health Society on monthly basis before 5th of next month.
- 10. Physical achievements/ work done of these Programmes, alongwith line listing, should be regularly sent to State Health Society on monthly basis.
- 11. Further funds will be released only after submission of physical and financial progress, alongwith end utilization certificates.
- 12. The account of the Implementing Agencies/ District Health Society shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of the Health & Family Welfare, GoI whenever the Society is called upon to do so.
