Sub: Release of funds for implementation of Population based Screening for Non-

Sir,

In light of the decision of the Executive Committee meeting held on 11th October, 2017 and the instructions from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India emphasizing upon implementation of population based screening for Non-Communicable Diseases during – 2017-18, sanction is hereby accorded to the release of Rs.56.97 Lakhs (Rupees Fifty Six Lakhs and Ninety Seven Thousand only) as 75% of Grant-in-Aid for trainings of ASHAs and ANMs in the identified Districts for implementation of population based screening of Non-Communicable Diseases during the financial year – 2017-18.

Accordingly, these funds are electronically transferred, out of funds approved under Mission Flexible Pool – Budget Head "Universal Health Check Up and Screening of NCDs – B.18.2", to your bank accounts as per following details:

The Grant-in-Aid is subject to the conditions that:

- The above GIA is towards 75% of funds approved for training of ASHAs and ANMs to ensure population based screening of NCDs in the identified Districts. However, requisition for remaining funds can be submitted after submission of end utilization certificate/FMR.
- 2. District-wise action plan for implementation of population-based screening shall be strictly adhered to so as to ensure coverage of population as envisaged

vide this office communication No.: SHS/NHM/J&K/NCD/2017/13540-50 dated: 14.11.2017. Compliance report for the same be submitted to this office immediately after completion of the training schedule alongwith detailed list of ASHAs & ANMs trained for the purpose.

- 3. Funds shall be utilized after observing all codal formalities required under rules and according to the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India which are available on the website http://nrhm.gov.in/.
- 4. State Health Society will release the funds in your favour on PFMS portal and the same shall be accepted after confirming receipt of funds from your bank and subsequent release/ utilization of these funds shall be through PFMS portal.
- 5. Optimum utilization of funds shall be ensured alongwith avoidance of unnecessary parking of funds.
- 6. The Statement of Expenditure (SoE)/FMR in customized Tally ERP and Utilization Certificate (UC) is to be sent to State Health Society on monthly basis before 5th of next month.
- 7. Physical achievements/ work done of the Programme, alongwith line listing, should be regularly sent to State Health Society on monthly basis.
- 8. Proper record of Cash Book, Ledger, Asset Register and other records shall be maintained under seal & signatures of the concerned officers and shall be made available for checking by any of the visiting team from Central/ State Govt.
- 9. The account of the Implementing Agencies shall be open to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal Audit by Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of the Health & Family Welfare, GoI whenever the Society is called upon to do so.
