Sub: - Advertisement Notice for Bridge Programme (6 months Certificate Course) in Community Health for Ayurvedic/ Unani graduates and GNM/ BSc Nursing.

Applications from open market are invited from Ayurvedic/ Unani graduates and GNM or BSc Nursing (In-service Regular/ Contractual not allowed) for admission to Bridge Programme six (6) months Certificate Course in Community Health for Ayurvedic graduates/ Unani graduates and GNM or BSc Nursing, to equip them with competencies/ skills for providing Comprehensive Primary Healthcare at identified Public Health Institutions i.e. upgraded Sub-Centres as Health & Wellness Centres. For Ayurvedic graduates and GNM or BSc Nursing, the course will be conducted through IGNOU and for Unani graduates the course will be conducted through University of Kashmir.

The applicants who are willing to serve in rural and hard to reach areas of State at Sub- Centre- Health & Wellness Centres should only apply. Programme Study Centres for BPCCHN through IGNOU for Ayurvedic graduates and GNM or BSc Nursing are Government Hospital, Gandhi Nagar, Jammu; District Hospital, Udhampur; District Hospital, Rajouri; and District Hospital, Kathua in Jammu Division and District Hospital, Anantnag; District Hospital, Baramulla; in Kashmir Division. For Unani Graduates, District Hospital, Pulwama and Govt. JLNM Hospital, Srinagar will be the Programme Study Centres for the course through University of Kashmir.

The interested eligible candidates are advised to submit the application forms complete in all respects by or before 30th of June, 2019 till 4:00 pm in the office of State Health Society, at Regional Institute of Health & Family Welfare, Nagrota for Jammu Division and Divisional Office, NHM, Ground Floor, Block- A, Old Secretariat, Srinagar for Kashmir Division.

The Unani Graduates who have already submitted their application forms for Bridge Programme six (6) months Certificate Course in Community Health for Unani graduates in pursuance to this office corrigendum notification No. SHS/PS/NHM/ 2018 issued in continuation to advertisement notification No. SHS/ NHM/ J&K/ 4378-82 dated 16-05-2018, need not to apply afresh, their applications will be considered provided they fulfil the revised eligibility criteria on the date when they have submitted their application forms. i.e; the cut off date for calculation of their upper age limit (45 years) shall be 25th of June 2018.

Terms & Conditions:

- 1. The candidate should be permanent resident of J&K State.
- 2. Preference will be given to local candidates based on the district merit.
- 3. Details of number of vacancies available in each district is uploaded on the official website: www.jknhm.com and also in NMH office Jammu/ Srinagar. Vacancies indicated are tentative and subject to change.
- 4. All essential documents will be verified on the day of skill assessment/counseling.
- 5. All applications will be subjected to a screening process and only shortlisted eligible candidates will have to undergo a written examination conducted by State Health Society. The merit list will be based on performance in written test and skill assessment/interview.
- 6. Final selection of the candidates will be done based on the district wise merit in written test and interview/ skill assessment test and counselling for allotment of Programme Study Centre and district of placement. The number of candidates for each district will be as per the number of available vacancies. In case there is shortfall in any district due to non availability of eligible candidates, then State

- merit shall be operated and candidates belonging to other districts shall be considered.
- 7. All the selected eligible candidates shall have to submit a bank guarantee of rupees Sixty Thousand (Rs.60000) in favour of FA & CAO, NHM, J&K for a period of one year at the time of joining the BPCCHN.
- 8. Before deputation to the Programme Study Centre, the selected candidate shall submit an affidavit/ undertaking duly attested by First Class Judicial Magistrate to the extent that mere completion of training course shall not vest any right to claim for hiring in the State on Contractual basis under NHM, besides other terms and conditions laid down in the format of affidavit.
- 9. In case a candidate is selected for the BPCCHN, and successfully completes the six (6) months certificate course, he or she may be placed at the identified Health & Wellness Centre- Sub Centre.
- 10. The engagement shall be purely on contractual basis for one year and the contract may be renewed further based on the performance of the candidate and approval of post in PIP of NHM for the next financial year.
- 11. Number of probable permissibility is 30 candidates each in Programme Study Centre DH Anantnag, DH Baramulla, DH Kathua & DH Rajouri and 50 candidates each for Programme Study Centre Gandhi Nagar Jammu/ DH Udhampur for Ayurvedic graduates/ GNM or BSc Nursing through IGNOU. The probable permissibility is 60 each in Programme Study Centre DH Pulwama & JLNM Hospital Srinagar through Kashmir University. The number of permissibility of each Programme Study Centre is subject to change without any notification.
